The Easter Bunny or Hare is a folkloric figure and symbol of Easter bringing Easter eggs. Originating among German Lutherans, the Easter Hare" originally played the role of a judge, evaluating whether children were good or disobedient in behavior at the start of the season of East-

ertide, similar to the "naughty or nice" list made by Santa Claus. As part of the legend, the creature carries colored eggs in its basket, as well as candy, and sometimes toys to the home of children. As such, the Easter Bunny again shows similarities to Santa by bringing gifts to children on the night before a holiday. The custom was first mentioned in 1682.
