Egg Hunt area

PARKING

Parking allowable in blue shaded areas OR on the side streets where allowable.

PRIOR TO EVENT

No walking/cutting through the park.
Remain at the perimeter of the park
until the horn/siren signals the start of
the event.

INFORMATION AREA

Main pavilion designated for turning in golden eggs. Also, site of first aid and lost child area.

TODDLER AREA

This is a special area where toddlers can search for eggs in a special area filled with straw, eggs, and surprises! (They can also search the rest of the park too)

EASTER BUNNY


Bunny will be available for pictures until the designated end time of your session (11:30am/1:30pm).

FIRETRUCK

Visit the firetruck with our friends from the NTFD.

LIMIT 8-10 EGGS PER CHILD!

This a rain or shine event!



THINGS TO NOTE...

Prior to the event:

- 1. Be sure to have a bag or bucket to collect your easter eggs.
- 2. Make sure the kiddos have gone to the bathroom. There is a porta potty on site; however the permanent bathrooms are still winterized (to prevent pipes from freezing) and won't be available for use for this event.

Once you arrive:

- 1. When you arrive at the event, do not venture into the park and begin looking for eggs. line up on the perimeter of the park and wait for the signal for the beginning of the event.
- 2. Once the event begins, you may enter the park and begin searching for eggs.
 - a. **Golden Eggs** There are 100 golden eggs hidden throughout the park. If you find a golden egg return it to the information area and exchange it for a large chocolate prize. (LIMIT 1 GOLD EGG PER CHILD). If your child has already found a golden egg, leave any other golden egg for another participant. Hint: You'll have to look hard to find the golden eggs!
 - b. **Colored Eggs** Thousands of colored eggs are scattered throughout the park. Eggs will contain small candy and toys. Keep the eggs when you find them and enjoy the prize inside. To make sure every child gets opportunities to find eggs, every child is limited to finding 8-10 eggs. Staff & volunteers will be walking around the park throughout the event re-hiding colored eggs to ensure everyone gets a chance to grab some!

Easter Bunny:

1. The Easter Bunny will be available for pictures at the area designated on the map.

Toddler Area:

1. A specific area will be fenced off specifically for kids 5 & under to participate in a special egg hunt station. The station will be filled with straw, decorations and eggs. Kids will be let into the area in small groups, given an opportunity to find 3-4 eggs and then exit. Once completed they can move on to the rest of the egg hunt and activities. (Toddlers don't have to visit this area, it's just an added bonus).

Meet the Alpacas:

1. Our alpaca friends will be on hand for visitation. Stop on by and say hello! Note they may not be available depending on the weather.
